
We are pleased to announce that Sinclair Broadcast Group, Inc. ("Sinclair") has entered into an affiliation agreement with the CW Network, LLC to launch the CW Network on the fourth digital multicast channel of WJAC (Johnstown, PA) ("WJAC-D4"). The CW Network will launch on WJAC-D4 on September 16, 2019. To accommodate the launch of the CW Network on WJAC-D4, effective September 16, 2019, WJAC-D4 will no longer broadcast TBD. We are excited about this change in our program lineup, and think your member's viewers will be pleased with the addition of the CW Network to the Johnstown, PA designated market area ("DMA").

Reference is hereby made to the that certain retransmission consent agreement by and between Sinclair Television Group, Inc. and the National Cable Television Cooperative, Inc., effective as of January 1, 2018 (the "NCTC RTC Agreement"). Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the NCTC RTC Agreement. Please note, WJAC-D4 is a DTV Multiplexed Signal, which Participating Members operating within the Johnstown DMA are required to carry to all of their in-market subscribers pursuant to the terms and conditions of the NCTC RTC Agreement. Additionally, effective September 16, 2019 and thereafter through the remainder of the term of the NCTC RTC Agreement, all such Participating Members shall remit payment for carriage of WJAC-D4 at the then-prevailing per subscriber rate applicable to carriage of CW-affiliated DTV Signals (as defined in the NCTC RTC Agreement).

We have sent notices to all affected Participating Members, informing them of this program lineup change, but we wanted to make sure NCTC was aware of this change as well.

Should you have any questions related to this letter, please do not hesitate to contact the undersigned. We look forward to continuing our mutually beneficial relationships and are excited about the CW Network programming we will now be able to bring to viewers in the Johnstown, PA DMA.
