

Hello Sony Movies / Sony Cine Affiliate,

This notification is to inform you that two Sony domestic channels, **Sony Movies** and **Sony Cine**, are moving transmission/uplink from Encompass, Atlanta Facility to **Comcast Dry Creek Facility, Centennial, CO**.

As part of the transition, Sony Movies and Sony Cine will move from Galaxy 30, Transponder 10, to **SES-3, Transponder 12** as follows:

SES 3, T12 dual illumination – Thursday, July 1, 2021 (the first day affiliates can make the switch)

SES 3, T12 hard launch – Thursday, September 30, 2021 (the last day affiliates can make the switch)

No additional equipment will be needed as both Galaxy 30 – T10 and SES-3 – T12 are on the Cisco PowerVu encryption platform.

You will be notified when SES-3, T12, is available for you to make the move, and we will work with you to perform authorizations for a smooth transition as early as possible.

All affiliates receiving Sony Movies and Sony Cine feeds from Galaxy 30 will need to obtain re-authorization, as well as re-tune receivers to SES-3 Transponder 12 by **September 30, 2021**. These channels were officially rebranded on February 1, 2021 as Sony Movies and Sony Cine. The previous channel names were Sony Movie Channel and Cine Sony, respectively.

Effective October 1, 2021, Sony Movies and Sony Cine feeds will only be available on SES-3 Transponder 12.

Technical specifications and instructions for the SES-3 – T12 satellite move will be sent to affiliates the first week of May 2021. In the meantime, please forward this notification to your engineering and technical departments.
