Dear President,

In April 2021, Weather Group Television, LLC informed you that we were preparing to transition the Network's HD broadcast feed from an MPEG-2 to an MPEG-4 compression standard. Preparations are still underway and we now anticipate this transition to occur between mid-October 2021 and mid-January 2022.

As a reminder, we will provide both MPEG-2 and MPEG-4 compression HD feeds of the Network during the transition and there will be no required changes to the Intellistars. We will also work with your engineering team to schedule around any year-end projects, holidays, and provide ample testing time to ensure a smooth transition.

No action is required at this time. We will work directly with your engineering teams once the preparations are complete. In the meantime, please do not hesitate to contact me if there are any questions.


RE: Timely Official MPEG 2 to MPEG 4 Transition Notice

To Whom It May Concern:

Weather Group Television, LLC, owner of The Weather Channel television network (the "Network"), is writing to inform you that as we continue to invest in the latest technology, we are preparing to transition the Network's HD broadcast feed from an MPEG-2 to an MPEG-4 compression standard, similar to many other cable networks. We anticipate this transition to occur between June and September of 2021. As part of the transition, we will temporarily provide both MPEG-2 and MPEG-4 compression HD feeds of the Network. There will be no required changes to the Intellistars, at this time, as they will continue to output MPEG-2 feeds.

Our engineers will coordinate with your engineers at the headends as part of the transition, but currently no action is needed from you. We will provide more details, including a specific timeframe of the transition, in the near future.
