

From Ryan Vandewiele, VP and General Counsel:

Following is information from a letter we are mailing out today via certified mail. However, given the short timeframe, we wanted to give you as much notice as possible.

We previously notified you that KSTC-TV is changing its over-the-air channel following the recent television spectrum auction. This letter will serve as notice that due to unexpected delays, KSTC-TV, Minneapolis, Minnesota (the "Station"), will be changing its over-the-air channel on September 4, 2019, at 12:00 p.m., not on August 23, 2019, as previously scheduled.

The Station will terminate operations on Channel 45 and will begin operations on Channel 30 pursuant to the following parameters:

Over the Air Channel: 30

Transmitter/Antenna Address: 960 County Road F, Shoreview, MN 55126

Transmitter/Antenna Coordinates: 45° 03' 45.00" N Latitude, 93° 08' 22.00" W Longitude

Antenna Height (above mean sea level): 706.3 meters

Effective Radiated Power: 1000 kW
